

# Knitting Pattern Kp141: The Perfect Premie or Doll Outfit for Your Little One

## Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn (approximately 200 yards for the jacket, 50 yards for the hat, and 50 yards for the trousers)
- Size 6 (4.00 mm) knitting needles
- Tapestry needle
- Buttons (optional)

## Gauge:

- 5 stitches = 1 inch in stockinette stitch

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- CO: Cast on
- K: Knit
- P: Purl
- Rep: Repeat
- St: Stitch

## **Instructions:**

### **Jacket:**

- CO 50 sts.
- K1, P1 rib for 2 inches.
- Change to stockinette stitch (K every row).
- Knit until the piece measures 8 inches from the cast-on edge.
- Shape the shoulders by binding off 5 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
- Continue knitting until the piece measures 10 inches from the cast-on edge.
- Bind off all sts.

### **Hat:**

- CO 36 sts.

- K1, P1 rib for 2 inches.
- Change to stockinette stitch (K every row).
- Knit until the piece measures 5 inches from the cast-on edge.
- Shape the crown by knitting 2 sts together at the end of the next 2 rows.
- Rep the previous step until there are 12 sts remaining.
- Cut the yarn, leaving a 6-inch tail.
- Thread the tail through the remaining sts and pull tight to close the crown.

### **Trousers:**

- CO 24 sts.
- K1, P1 rib for 2 inches.
- Change to stockinette stitch (K every row).
- Knit until the piece measures 6 inches from the cast-on edge.
- Shape the legs by binding off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.
- Continue knitting until the piece measures 8 inches from the cast-on edge.
- Bind off all sts.

### **Finishing:**

- Sew the side seams of the jacket and trousers.

- Sew the top of the hat to the brim.
- If desired, sew buttons to the front of the jacket.

## Variations:

- You can use any type of worsted weight yarn to make this outfit.
- You can change the colors of the yarn to create a unique look.
- You can add embellishments to the garments, such as embroidery or lace.
- You can make the garments larger or smaller by adjusting the number of stitches you cast on.

This knitting pattern is a great way to create a special and unique outfit for your preemie or doll. The garments are easy to knit and can be made in a variety of colors and yarns to match your own unique style. So grab your needles and yarn and get started today!



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
