



*accompany someone*

If you want, they can **come along**.

## 7. Keep to

*Persist in, continue*

He **kept to** puzzle until it was done.

## 8. Make over

*Do again*

The teacher **made him** do his homework **over**.

## 9. Do without

*Manage without something one needs*

She can't **do without** a bicycle.

## 10. Hold on

*To wait particularly on the phone*

They'll **hold on** another minute, then they'll have to go.




